

Permission Form for STEAM Kit Checkout

STEAM kits are available for checkout in the library using the same process as checking out books. STEAM kits cover a variety of skills from coding to science to art and everything between. Checking out a kit from the library is a great way to develop skills and concepts taught in class at your own pace at home.

All students checking out STEAM kits **must** have this form signed by a parent or guardian.

Because some of these kits can be quite pricey, you do need parental agreement to access them in case of damage or loss.

Fine policy:

- STEAM kits have numerous, small pieces that are used to create the final project. If pieces are missing that are not fundamental to completing the project, you will not be charged.
- If pieces are missing that prevent the project from being completed, you may be required to pay the full fee to replace the kit.
- If it is possible to replace only the missing parts, you will only be charged for the specific pieces that are missing.

This form needs to be signed before students can check-out STEAM Kits. You can scan and email it back to me or have your child drop it by the library.
